

- **Picket fence** establishes boundaries, is pleasing architecturally and allows for high visibility.

- **Semi-privacy fence** grants limited visibility, establishes boundaries and allows for air flow making it resistant to strong wind and storms.

- **Wood** is traditional, renewable, economical and requires some routine maintenance.



- **Chain link** offers unobstructed views, durability, security and economy.

## Material

- **Privacy fence** establishes boundaries and prevents unwelcome observation.

- **Ornamental iron** is beautiful, strong, secure and requires some routine maintenance.



- **Vinyl** is splinter-free, low-maintenance, durable and long-lasting.

# Choosing a Kid-Friendly Fence



- Fencing steep or hilly terrain may require a stepped installation if the material is not rackable, or adjustable to the slope. Small children could get their hands or feet trapped under a stepped fence.



- Location of your fence is important if you want your children to be in view while they play outside.



## Landscape

- If a pool is in the same area where children play, the pool should be enclosed separately from the play area, with code compliant fencing and properly latched gates. Adult supervision should always be used when children are playing near pools.



- If you want to fence both the front and back yard, using two different materials, such as wood for the front and chain link for the back will be easier on the budget.
